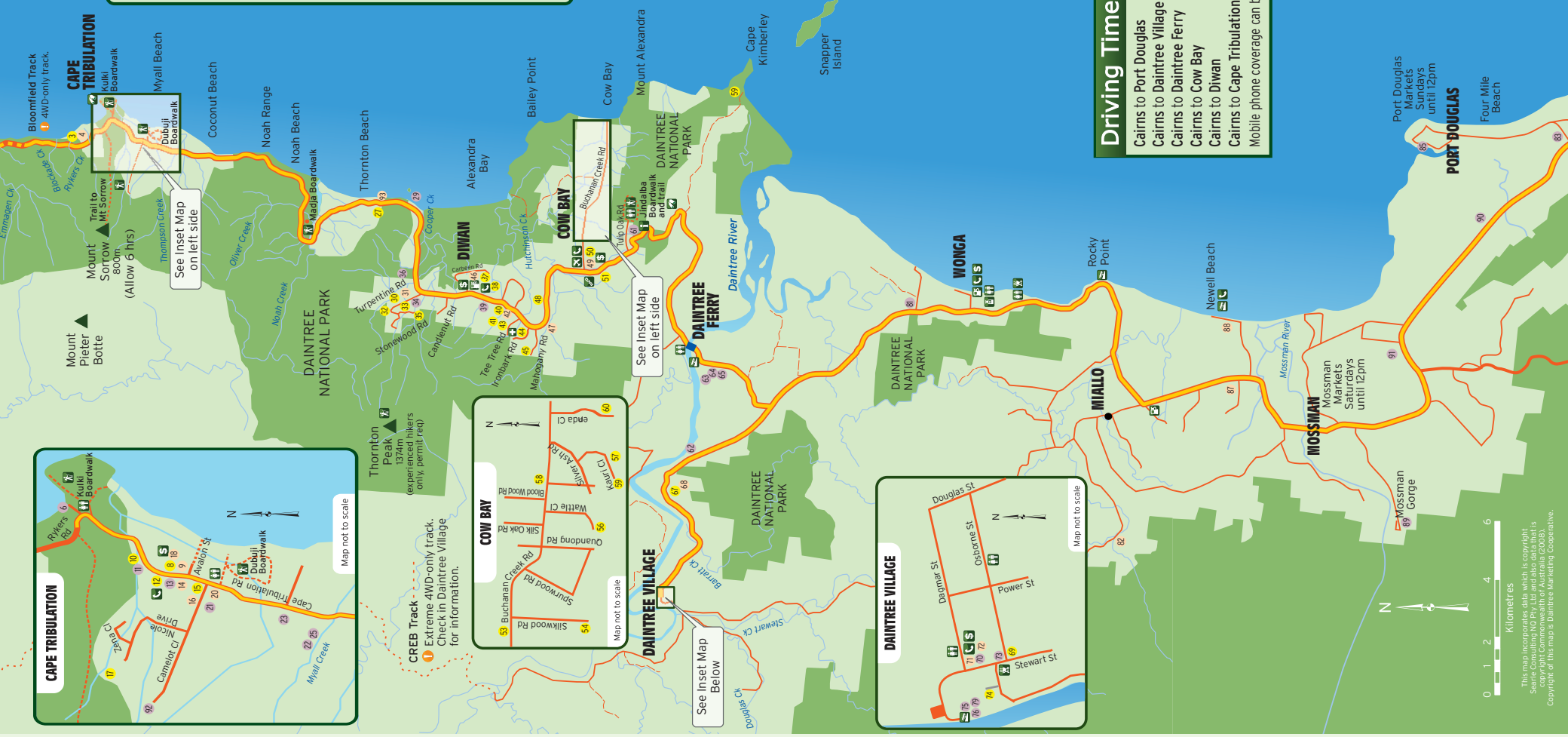

- Consider staying a few nights at one of the many accommodation offerings, there is much to experience in the Daintree
- Driving times indicated are for direct journeys.
- Last fuel stop south of the Daintree River is at Wonga Beach then north of the River at no. 37
- Ferry operates 5am until midnight. Allow for delays in peak season June-Oct heading north 9-11am & south 3-5pm.
- Take care of wildlife crossing.
- Be crocwise, lookout for warning signs.
- Stingers present November to May.
- Mobile coverage varies

 - Cairns to Cape Tribulation 2 hrs 30 mins 154 km
